Dear Fellowship...

I recall reading an article a few years back, that told the story of a parish church in which the church meetings became dominated by the topic of re-decorating, to the point that people argued, fell out with each other and eventually the church split. How very sad! It left me wondering if all those having a say in the decisions of the church were really born again.

At Measham Baptist Church, our decisions are made at the church meetings by all who are church members, and this is where the ultimate accountability lies. We believe in the priesthood of all believers (1 Peter 2 vs 9). Along with many others, over the years you may have wondered what is the Biblical basis for church membership, why we operate this way and why we are so keen for people to join.

The Bible clearly warns us of false prophets and 'wolves in sheep's clothing', in other words apparent believers who may join us with the ultimate aim of causing harm, possibly what happened in my opening story. We are told to be on our guard and seek to protect the church from such people. But a far greater and more joyful theme of the New Testament, where we see the blueprint for our church, is that of a close-knit and interdependent family. A family that loves being together, worships together, socialises together and makes decisions together. As a previous minister used to say 'Make much of God's people'. Acts 4 vs 32 tells us the believers were one in heart (their shared worship and love) and one in mind (their shared understanding and decision making).

When Paula and I met and decided to build a life and a family together, we did not have to get married, we could have lived together and still loved each other and had children. But, like many others, we wanted to marry and make our commitment that much more serious, more definite, more public and ultimately more Biblical.
