## ***Dear Fellowship...***

### **1 Corinthians 12 vs 24-27**

*24...But God has combined the members of the body and has given greater honour to the parts that lacked it, 25 so that there should be no division in the body, but that its parts should have equal concern for each other. 26 If one part suffers, every part suffers with it; if one part is honoured, every part rejoices with it. 27 Now you are the body of Christ and each one of you is a part of it.*

This will be a familiar passage to us regarding how Paul compares the body of Christ to a human body. All parts are different, but all parts are important for the functioning of the whole. Also, none of the parts should think of themselves as either superior or inferior to any of the others.

We are all different in our fellowship but we all have one thing in common - faith in Christ. It is a contradiction of vs 26 and 27 to think we can be private, isolated Christians. We are called in these verses to be involved in the lives of our fellow believers.

We now have quite a few in our fellowship who are not official members of the church and sadly, therefore, are excluded from church meetings where decisions are made that affect us all. Paul says God has combined the members of the body. If you have not yet considered becoming a member of the church, I would urge you to think and pray about it. Your present contributions are greatly valued but as a member could become even more valuable!
